# Knitting Matters™

This is one of my favorite stitch patterns, and when I just *happened* to use it in this particular color it didn't take long to realize I'd have to name it Cupid's Arrows. Depending on your color choice, it could be just as suitable for a man, so I've included expanded sizing to accommodate that option. And you can see other people's versions of this on its Ravelry page if you need more inspiration.



This model was made using Nature Spun Worsted Weight, by Brown Sheep. Color N85W Peruvian Pink, (100% wool) (3.5 oz/100g) (245 yards/224 meters)

## PATTERN SPECIFICATIONS

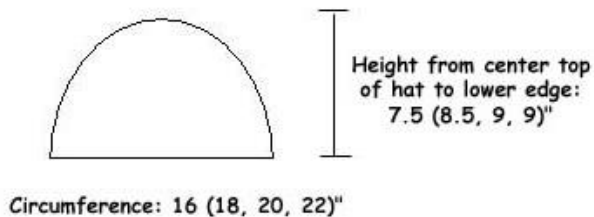
**Sizes:** Adult S (M, L, XL) - Measurements shown on schematic below. Choose size that is approx. 2" smaller than your head to insure a snug fit.

**Gauge:** 18 sts and 37 rows per 4" (10 cm) in Stranded Stitch Pattern on larger needles (or 20 sts per 4" in stockinette stitch).

**Needles:** Size 8US (5.0mm) double point needles (or size you need to get gauge). (You can also use long circular needles and the magic loop method if you're familiar with that way of knitting in the round.) Optional: double point needles 2 sizes smaller for edging if you prefer a tighter ribbing.

**Yarn:** 100 (110, 125, 150) yards/91 (100, 114, 137) meters of a worsted weight yarn.

**Notions needed:** Scissors, tapestry needle, and one stitch marker.
