Knitting Matters™

These fun fingerless gloves will have you playing with colors you'd never thought of combining before. They're knitted in the round with no sewing involved.



This pair shown in 'O-Wool Legacy DK' by Vermont Organic Fiber Co. (100% certified organic wool) (305 yd/280 m, 3.5 oz/100g)

Main color: Grove (4567); Contrast color: Sprig (3212)

PATTERN SPECIFICATIONS

Sizes: Medium (Large) - Circumference around palm, excluding thumb: 8 (9)" / 20 (23) cm.

Gauge: 24 sts and 40 rounds per 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch after blocking. Do a swatch to ensure success!

Yarn: DK weight yarn. **Main Color:** 85 (102) yds / 77 (93) meters; **Contrast Color:** 20 (25) yds / 18 (23) meters (Note: See the FlexTips box on the back page for an alternate color combining idea.)

Needles: Set of five size 4 US (3.5 mm) double points (or size YOU need to get gauge). Also, same needles in size 2US (3.0 mm) for ribbing. (You could use a long circular needle instead of the double points if you prefer to use the magic loop method.)

Notions: 2 stitch markers, scissors, tapestry needle, 8" piece of contrast color waste yarn to hold gusset sts.
