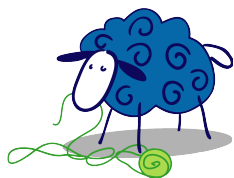


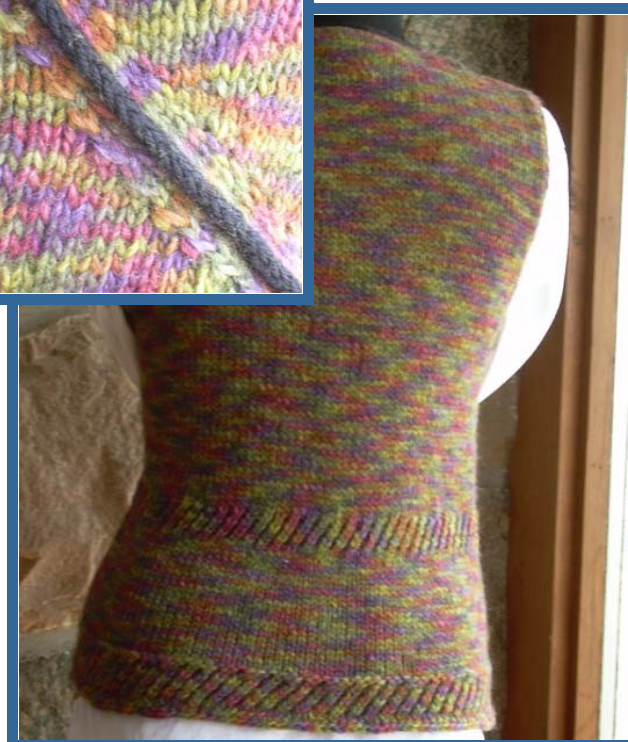
# Jellybean Vest

# Knitting Matters™

This quick and easy vest will add punch to your wardrobe. The front is a faux wrap construction, so it doesn't use as much yarn and you don't have the bulk of 2 layers of fabric. The twisted stitches on the lower hem and waistband suggest movement and give added interest. Slight waist shaping is provided simply by the different gauge of the twisted stitch pattern on the waistband.



This model was made in Tahki Bunny Print, (50% merino, 25% alpaca, 25% acrylic); 50 g/1.75 oz per ball;

81 yds/75 m); shown in size 32.5", used 6 balls of Bunny Print in color 018. The name "Jellybean" was inspired by the vivid colors in this yarn. The black i-cord trim is shown in Cascade 220.

## PATTERN SPECIFICATIONS

**Finished Chest Sizes:** 32.5 (37, 41, 43.75, 47.5, 49.25, 51.25)"/83 (94, 104, 111, 121, 125, 130) cm

**Gauge:** 17 sts and 23 rows per 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch and 21 sts per 4" (10cm) in twist pattern on larger needles.

**Needles:** Size 9 US (5.5 mm) needles for body, and size 7 US (4.5 mm) 32" circular needles and one dp or straight needle for i-cord trim, or sizes you need to get gauge. As always, do a gauge swatch before you start.

**Yarn:** **MC:** 440 (515, 580, 645, 730, 765, 815) yds; **CC:** 20 (20, 20, 25, 25, 30, 30) yds.

**Notions:** stitch marker, crochet hook in same size as larger knitting needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, tapestry needle & scissors.
