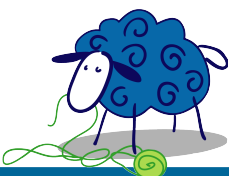

# Knitting Matters™

WEAR your veggies with this shape-flattering shell made in Cornucopia from Kollage Yarns. This soft, stretchy tape yarn made from corn is perfect for wearing next to the skin as a tank, and just as suited to being worn as a vest. See the FlexTips box for yarn substitution suggestions.



This model was made using Cornucopia by Kollage Yarns (100% corn; 34g/100 yds), in the following colors:  
MC: Turkish Sea, CC1: Capri Blue, CC2: Island Sea, CC3: Fern

## PATTERN SPECIFICATIONS

**Finished Chest Sizes:** 33.5 (37.5, 41.5, 45.5, 49.5, 53.5)"/85 (95, 105, 115, 126, 136) cm

**Gauge:** 23 sts and 30 rows per 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch.

**Needles:** Size 6US (4.0mm) straight or circular needles for body; size 4 US (3.5mm) 24" circular and double-point needles for edgings (or sizes you need to get gauge). Your edging needle should be 2 sizes smaller than your larger needle.

**Yarn:** MC: 500 (610, 700, 775, 875, 950) yds; CC1 and CC2: 75 (80, 90, 100, 115, 125) yds each; CC3: 125 (155, 180, 200, 225, 250) yds.

**Notions:** tapestry needle, crochet hook size G (4.0 mm), 2 stitch markers
